So please make sure the score sheet includes the following information.

- Your name, and age if under 18
- Distances and Round shot
- For Metric distances, the face size, 122cm or 80cms
- Total scores for each distance, (Yards - 5 zone scoring and Metres 10 zone scoring)
- Please remember you must not record your own scores on the score sheet. Call out your scores and let the Target Captain write them down.
- And finally, sign your score sheet and have it also signed by the designated Target captain.
